Note: Scholarship funds will be awarded directly to the Educational Institution the recipient will be attending.

Award Components: Scholarship awarded to student(s) by the Woman's Club of South Norfolk Scholarship Committee. Award amount to TBD by the club membership.

Criteria: Applicant must be a graduating Oscar Smith High School senior and live in the **23324** Zip Code. Additionally, the recipient **must** attend our Scholarship Award Reception or send a representative in their place, otherwise, the scholarship will be withdrawn.

Application Process: Applicant must submit the following six (6) items:

- 1. Completed application form (if handwritten, please print legibly)
- 2. Personal statement, in one hundred (100) words or less, on why you want to attend college, Trade School or further training (such as Beauty School, Automotive, Computer, IT, etc.)
- 3. One (1) Reference Letter from a teacher (include signature, title, and contact information)
- 4. One (1) Personal Reference Letter from someone NOT related to you (include signature, title, and contact information)
- 5. Most recent official Transcript of grades
- 6. Parent(s) or legal guardian(s) signature and date on the application where specified

Selection Process: The Scholarship Committee will select scholarship recipient(s) based on the information provided in the application and supporting documentation. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
